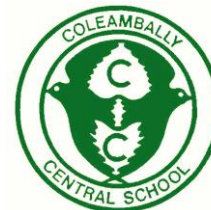

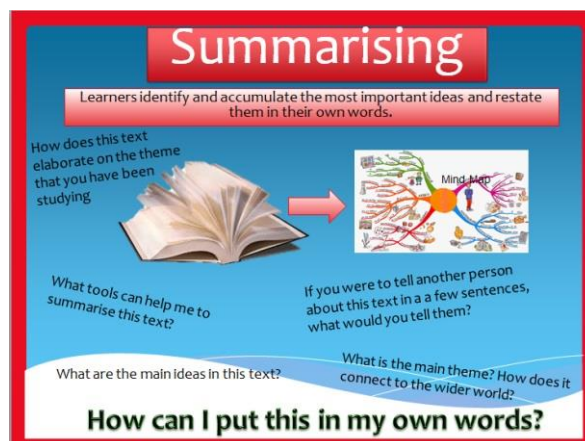

A summary is a shortened version of a text that contains all the main points. Summarising is an important skill that helps when we are researching, gathering and presenting information. Finding key words and phrases helps to summarise the text. These skills are essential for all students to gain a deeper understanding of what they are reading.
